

Lyubomir Andreev is one of the first professional wildlife photographers in Bulgaria. He was born in 1968 in Sofia. Since his early age he has been charmed by the wonderful world of wild creatures. His first love are the birds. He is one of the people who held a fifteen-years-long programme for observing the bird migration at "VIA PONTICA". On these land studies for the first time he took a look at the world through the lens of the photocamera and finally found himself.

At first Lyubomir used a hand-made camera-gun for black & white pictures only. In 1989 he started working colour reversible processes and two years later he was already Free-lance professional wildlife photographer.

Lyubomir`s favorite "prey" are rare bird species but in fact he has turned the eye of his camera toward most of the live creatures and beautiful places of wilderness. His wonderful pictures of flowers, tiny and huge animals, forests, mountains and lakes are his message full of love and delight of everything in the Bulgarian nature.

The first official acknowledgement in Bulgaria was at the NATIONAL PHOTOGRAPHIC COMPETITION `93 where Lyubomir Andreev was given the SPECIAL AWARD for the best colour slide series. His pictures were used for illustrations in special editions of the Ministry of Environment and Water as well as in Nature protection materials, calendars, posters and popular articles.
